- 4. On Wednesdays I upload a Bible class for your study on Facebook. The radio program is dealing with a passage that is frequently twisted by some, so I am spending a few weeks digging deeper into that material in this Wednesday class.
- 5. Around midweek I try to get the bulletin mailed along with Bible study materials for our younger classes. This provides materials for the smaller kids, keeps all posted on the latest News 'n Notes, provides the weekly Bible Reading Schedule, and offers other study aids for us to use at home for further Bible Study.
- 6. On Wednesdays Bro. Barry Lee has put together an interactive Bible Class on the internet for the teens using the Zoom App. He has had ten or more students from Eubank in each of his classes so far. I am so encouraged by their participation!
- 7. Several of us are trying to call around and check on folks to see if there are any needs we can address. Please feel free to call others just to chat and ease the burdens we all are facing right now. Sending a card would be nice. For some of us isolation is tough!

More ideas are brewing as to what we can do to provide more study options and connections while we are parted. Please pray for one another and help out as you can. I pray God is being glorified, and this church is growing stronger as a result of this "present distress."
